THE CONTEXT OF THIS GUIDANCE (any background details)

Most serious violence has now formed the basis of the Government's long term violence strategy.

In February 2008 the Government published its cross Government action plan for tackling violence, 'Saving Lives. Reducing Harm. Protecting the Public'. This plan set out a number of actions for both Government Departments and local Crime & Disorder Reduction Partnerships to tackle violence.

In April 2008 the Government published a suite of PSA targets. PSA 23(1) specifically priorities most serious violence.

THE OBJECTIVES OF THIS GUIDANCE

This guidance aims to provide practical implementation advice for local partnerships to support the implementation of the actions contained within the Tackling Violence Action Plan.

It will support local partnerships in developing targeted responses to the particular violent crime challenges they face within each area. It will provide information on tools, processes and structures to assist frontline practitioners to deliver change on the ground.
